Extract from Statutes	
Membership at Large	

a. Members at Large

- Persons residing in cities not having local Societies of the American Turners, or former members of a Society that has withdrawn from the American Turners or whose Society was dissolved, may become members at large, provided they meet the requirements of D8 of these by-laws.
- ii. Membership at large may be issued to individuals at least eighteen (18) years of age provided they meet all other requirements for membership as provided in these By-laws.
- iii. Applications for membership at large shall be made to the National Office
- iv. Applicants shall declare their assent to the By-Laws of the American Turners, and shall properly submit an application furnished by the National Office.
- v. Applications of former members who have been expelled shall not be considered.
- vi. The National Office shall publish in two successive issues of the official organ, the names of all applicants for membership at large. Protests against the admission of an application must be submitted to the National Office within thirty days from the second publication.
- vii. The annual dues of members at large shall be \$50.00 or as revised by vote of the National Convention. Dues will be submitted to the National Office with the application, by the first day of January.
- viii. Members-At-Large of the American Turners shall have the privilege of competing at all competitive events at the District and National level, but may not hold office at the local, District or National levels but may vote according to federal votes at the National Convention.
- ix. Honorary 40 year members of the American Turners, who have formerly been members of a Society that has withdrawn from the American Turners or whose Society was dissolved, shall hereafter be classified as members at large unless they become members of another active Society.
