



FESTIVAL REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

When preparing to complete your on-line registration, please follow all directions on the form, including the directions in **red**. In addition, here are a few more helpful hints to keep in mind:

- An asterisk * indicates a field that **MUST** be filled in.
- An arrow ∨ indicates a drop-down box, which contains different options to choose from.
- **Once you enter your date of birth and male or female, it will automatically populate the rest of the registration form with events that you are allowed to compete in, based on your age and gender.**
- Nat. Turner Number is your membership number that was issued in **2023** by the American Turners and is located on your membership card. It is a five (5) digit number, including the zeros. (Honorary members have a four (4) digit number).
 - If you have a family membership and you are the spouse of a member, add a "S" to the end of your (Spouse's) number. All Children of a member will add "C1" or "C2", etc., to the end of their parent's membership number. Example: John is a member with membership number 00001, his wife will enter 00001S, and their son will enter 00001C1 and their daughter will enter 00001C2
 - If both husband and wife have their own membership number, please enter your own number. If you have children (under 18), then choose one parent's number and add C1, C2, etc. on it to identify them as your children.
 - Youth members should enter a "Y" at the end of their number.
 - Honorary gold card members should enter a "H" at the end of their number.
 - All Non-member children (under 18 years of age) must enter "99999"
 - It will be verified that all Non-member children are enrolled and participate at their local society before they are allowed to compete at the Festival.
 - Please note, there is an additional \$10 fee for a Non-member child to compete.
 - Please **DO NOT** register your grandchildren with your number. They must use a parent's number, or have a Youth membership number, or register as a Non-member child.
 - While the "Person to Notify" field is not required, I strongly urge you to complete it, in case there is an emergency.
 - Please refer to the Tentative Schedule when deciding what events to compete in. Great effort was used to create a schedule with as few conflicts as possible, but there could be a few, depending on your age.
 - Gymnastics:
 - All girls/women under the age of 30 will choose their competition level, then will automatically be registered for 4 events. You can scratch an event at the Festival. Those Senior women between 30-49 will also automatically be registered for 4 events, but can scratch an event at the Festival.

- All boys/men under the age of 30 will automatically be signed up for 6 events. You can scratch an event at the Festival. Sr. Men (30+) must choose the four (4) events they want to compete on.
 - Senior Women, please review the Supplemental Handbook for all the various rules and options.
- Track & Field and Swimming:
 - Remember, only the events you are qualified to enter will be listed based on your gender and age.
 - If you plan on entering a running or swimming relay, you must have a society coordinator also submit a Roster with all the participants names listed. If you are the society coordinator for relays, please check “true”.
- Volleyball:
 - If your society has a team, the team captain must register on this form, include the team name and also have your society volleyball coordinator submit a Roster, which includes all team member’s names.
 - If your society does not have a full team, you must register on this form and then enter “looking for a team” in the Team Name field. A Roster must still be submitted, no matter how few players are from your society.
- Pickleball:
 - There are 4 age groups, and no gender preference.
 - A Roster must be submitted by the society coordinator, even if you only have one team.
- Golf:
 - A Roster must be submitted, even if you are the only golfer from your society and looking for a foursome to play on.
- Mass and Model Drills:
 - Please refer to the Festival Rulebook for applicable rules.
 - Don’t forget to order your Festival t-shirt if you are participating in the Mass Drill.
- Before clicking on the “Submit and Pay” button, review your entire registration to confirm all personal information is correct and you have entered in all the events you want to compete in. You can save your information (prior to payment) and return to it later to finish. You cannot come to the Festival and then ask to be added to an event.
- Payment can be made with your PayPal account, or as a guest with a debit or credit card by clicking the “Submit and Pay” button. If you want to pay with a debit or credit card, fill in the required information and then **uncheck** the blue button at the bottom of that page which says “save info and create a PayPal account”. Then click “continue as guest”.
- You must complete the payment process before you will receive your e-mail confirmation. If you did not receive an e-mail confirmation, make sure you finished the payment process. If you still do not receive an e-mail confirmation, contact Fred at blgst@comcast.net
- Print out the e-mail confirmation and bring it with you to the Festival.

- Rosters: All Rosters are found on the Festival page of the American Turner website and in the Registration form. Once the Roster is complete, click on the “Submit” button on the bottom of the page. No need to print and email it to anyone. But you might want to print it for your own records. Only the team captain/coordinator should complete roster(s) to avoid duplicate rosters being submitted for the same team. Rosters are also included on the registration form, which makes it convenient for the team captain/coordinator when he/she is submitting their own registration.
