Funding, in the form of reimbursement, will be made available for the support of cultural activity programs for any American Turner society in good standing. To qualify for said reimbursement, a request must be submitted, on a completed application form, approved by a Society Officer, and the Society's District Office. The Application Form is now available for downloading from the American Turner website. After having reviewed your application, the ATJEF Board of Trustees will determine the amount of your reimbursement.

Applications for reimbursement must be accompanied by receipts for expenses (materials, rentals, instructor fees, etc.); a description of your program; and a roster of program participants. All of these requirements are listed on the Application Form.

Eligibility for activities supported by this program is open to all members in good standing, children of members and all children registered in other society programs.
